ROOT POINTS

1. **Reproductive health** means having **healthy reproductive organs with normal functions**.
2. The **regulation of conception** by preventive methods or devices to limit the number of offspring is called **birth control**. There are some temporary methods and permanent methods.
3. **MTP**: Medical Termination of Pregnancy is intentional or Voluntary termination of pregnancy before the foetus becomes viable.
4. **STD**: Diseases or infections which are transmitted through sexual intercourse with infected persons are collectively called sexually transmitted diseases (STD) or venereal diseases (VD)
5. **Amniocentesis** is a diagnostic procedure to detect genetic defects in the unborn baby. **[IPE]**
