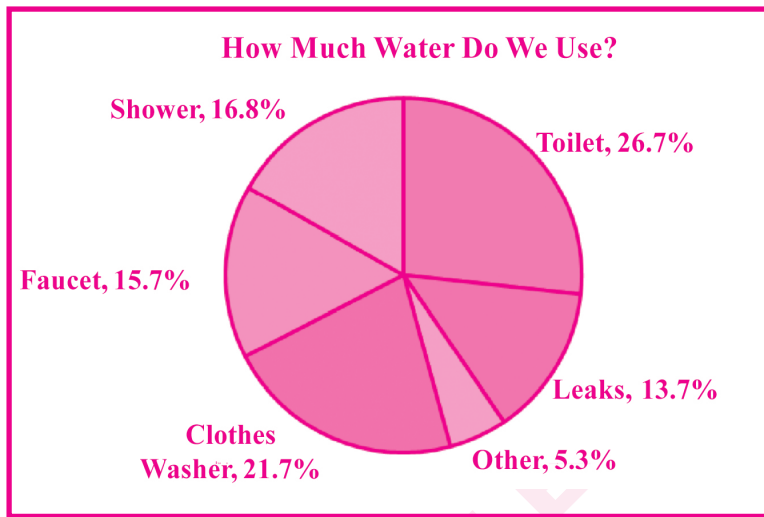

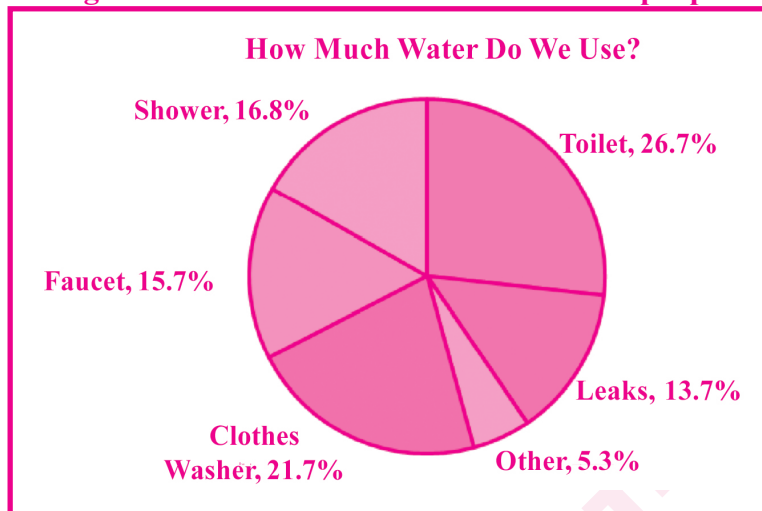

PROCESS OF WITHDRAWING MONEY FROM AN ATM

Debit cards are mostly used in ATMs, and it offers you to withdrawal cash which you have in your savings account. First insert your ATM card in the ATM machine.(you may see a blinking green light in the machine, where you have to put your card.) please mind to insert your card as the picture shows; otherwise the machine could not be able to read your card. Select the language you like. Enter your pin. You can see now many types of options like Withdraw Money, Deposit Money, Balance Enquiry, Bill Pay etc. To with draw cash you have to choose 'Cash Withdrawal' option.
