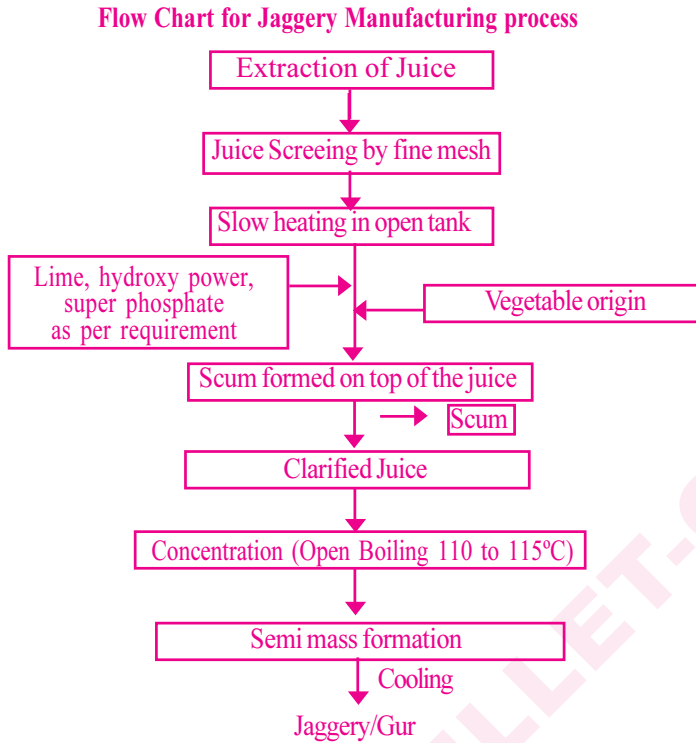

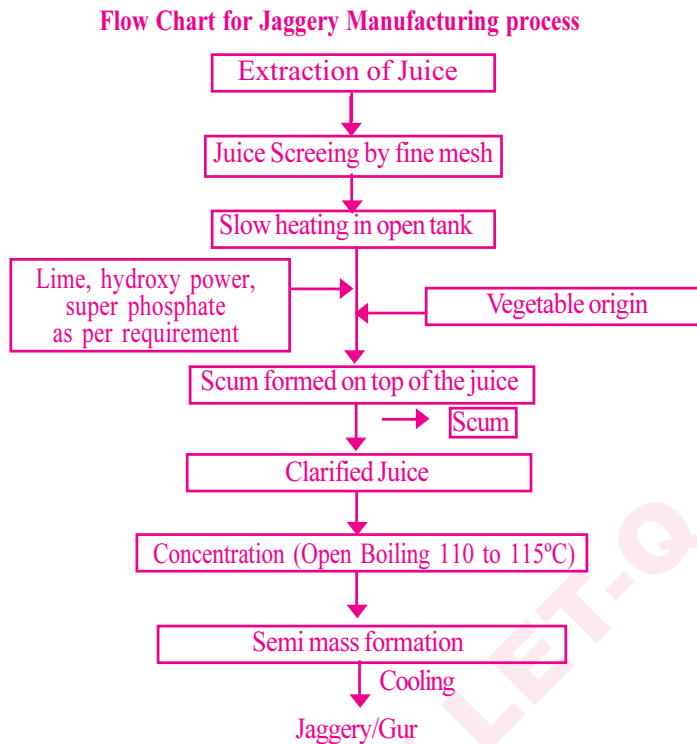

MAKING VEGETABLE FRIED RICE

Vegetable fried rice is one of the popular rice recipes. There are different ways in which it is made, but the basic version is described as follows:

First, take a cup of basmati rice in a bowl and wash thoroughly. Then, take some water in a sauce pan and add one table spoon of oil and salt to it. Once it comes to a boil, add the washed rice. Cook the rice till its 3/4th is done. Drain off the excess water and keep it aside. Now, take another pan and put 2 table spoons of oil in it. When the oil gets heated, add chopped onions, ginger garlic paste, spring onions and give it a stir. Then, add finely chooped carrot, shredded cabbage, diced capsicum, beans and green peas. Saute the vegetables for about 5 minutes. Now, season it with salt, pepper. Then give it a stir. Next fry the veggies on high flame. Do not overcook them. Now, add soya sauce, vinegar (optional) to the vegetables. Lastly, add the cooked rice. Give it a nice mix and serve hot.
